

Takemusu Iwama Aikido GB Grading Syllabus

6th Kyu to 4th Dan

The following grading syllabus is designed to guide students through a continuous development from 6th Kyu to 4th Dan.

The times between grades are minimums since the last grade was achieved. Students will only be able to take a test at their Instructor's discretion.

Be sure you have the required number of practice days before applying for an examination.

Minimum age for Shodan is 15 years, 4th Dan 22 years.

An examination shall be taken at the dojo where you normally practice.

As a rule partners (uke) in an examination should be of the same rank.

Continue doing the same technique, left and right, ura and omote, until the examiner says "Stop".

6th Kyu (no coloured belt)

Students must have trained for a minimum of 2 months.

Shodan (1st Degree black belt)

Students must have for a minimum of 12 months since 1st Kyu.

70 days of practice after obtaining 1st Kyu

Students must attend two TIA Europe Seminar in the 12 months prior to the test at least one of which must be taught by an instructor other than the candidate's normal teacher.

All techniques to be performed in Kihon unless otherwise instructed by the examiner.

Unarmed techniques: sitting, sitting vs. standing, standing techniques for strikes, thrusts, all forms of grasping (shoulders, elbows, collar, wrists and hands; all techniques from the rear)

Students must have for a minimum of 24 months since Shodan.

Minimum 1 year since 1st dan, with 200 days of practice

Students must attend two TIA Europe Seminar in the 12 months prior to the test at least one of which must be taught by an instructor other than the candidate's normal teacher.

All techniques to be performed in Kihon unless otherwise instructed by the examiner.

Same as shodan (above) plus Tantodori & Futarigake

Minimum 2 years since 2nd dan, with 300 days of practice

Students must attend two TIA Europe Seminar in the 12 months prior to the test at least one of which must be taught by an instructor other than the candidate's normal teacher.

All techniques to be performed in Ki No Nagare.

Same as nidan (above) plus Tachidori, Jodori & Taninzugake

Yondan (4th Degree black belt)

Students will be invited to give a demonstration at Sensei Sargeant and Sensei McGlones discretion.

Minimum 3 years since 3rd dan, with 400 days of practice

Jiyuwaza for all of the above

A demonstration from fifteen to twenty minutes showing a wide range of Tai Jutsu & Bukiwaza.

The demonstration should include Suwariwaza, Hanmihandachiwaza, Tachi waza, Kokyunage, Jo Dori, Tanto Dori, Tachi Dori, and Ninindori etc to show the wide range of understanding of the candidate.
